Workshops focus on the Indigenous history of the area around Todmorden Mills, a Toronto heritage site starting with a tour lead by members of First Story.

Wyandot multi-media artist Catherine Tamaro will be on hand as an artist mentor for the following workshops with members of inPrint as we make print-based artwork inspired by the tour.
